ASHRAE Certification

Certified HVAC Designer (CHD)



More than 2,750 certifications have been earned by professionals who have demonstrated their knowledge and expertise in the HVAC&R industry. Gain a competitive edge by earning an ASHRAE certification in HVAC design.
